We want you to know that your health & safety will remain our top priority as the situation evolves

PHASE 2

The Christina Lake Golf Club is following the lead of public health authorities and continuing to do our part to limit the spread of the virus.

Here are the steps we are taking:

- † **Pre Booked Tee Times available from 8:00am - 6:00pm.**
- † **Course is now open to both Members and Green Fee Players.**
- † **Must Call ahead for tee time bookings. No Walk-Ins.**
- † **Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your tee time. No earlier.**
- † **Driving Range is limited to 8 stalls in use at one time.**
- † **Putting Green is limited to 3 people at one time with a max of 10 minutes.**
- † **Food & Beverage will offer take out menu service only. 11:00am - 7:00pm**
- † **Concession available.**
- † **Clubhouse Take-Out Area limited to 4 people at one time.**
- † **Course washrooms now open. Mens & Ladies Clubhouse washrooms will remain open and stay limited to 2 people at a time.**
- † **Limit of 2 persons in Pro Shop at one time.**
- † **Tee Time intervals will now be 10 minutes apart. Continuing to support safe social distancing practices.**
- † **Limiting number of players on course at one time. Please be sure to call ahead.**
- † **We will continue to provide sanitizing stations.**
- † **Each green will have a modified cup. Pin in place. Please, DO NOT TOUCH THE PIN.**
- † **One player only per golf cart, unless from the same household.**
- † **No Benches.**
- † **No Rakes.**
- † **No on course Drinking Water supplied.**
- † **No Garbage Cans. Please, TAKE ALL YOUR GARBAGE WITH YOU.**
- † **Golfers must leave the course immediately following their round.**
- † Requiring our employees to stay home if they feel unwell or if they have been in contact with anyone that is exhibiting flu-like symptoms
- † Increased cleanliness of our facilities especially in high traffic areas
- † Notices throughout our facility for customers and employees to use caution and practice best hygiene methods to prevent the spread of the virus

The Christina Lake Golf Club will continue to monitor the recommendations of government and health officials as well as industry best practices and pass along relevant information and updates as necessary.
