The spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) and all of the variants in and around the world remains to be a concern for everyone even as the vaccine rolls out. *The Christina Lake Golf Club* continues to value the well-being and safety of our staff and guests. We want you to know that your health & safety will remain our top priority as we continue our 2021 season.

## Covid 2021 Protocol

*The Christina Lake Golf Club* is following the lead of public health authorities and continuing to do our part to limit the spread of the virus. Here are the steps we are continuing to take:

- ‡ **Masks are mandatory at all times in the Clubhouse.**
- ‡ **Course will continue to be open to both Members and Green Fee Players.**
- ‡ **Must Call ahead for tee time bookings. No Walk-Ins.**
- ‡ **Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your tee time. No earlier unless you plan to use our practice facilities.**
- ‡ **The Driving Range is limited to 8 stalls in use at one time.**
- ‡ **The Putting Green is limited to 6 people at one time with a max of 10 minutes.**
- ‡ **Food & Beverage open to dine in & take out menu service.**
- ‡ **Concession available.**
- ‡ **Clubhouse Take-Out Area limited to 6 people at one time.**
- ‡ **Course washrooms now open. Mens & Ladies Clubhouse washrooms will remain open and stay limited to 4 people at a time.**
- ‡ **Limit of 6 persons in Pro Shop at one time.**
- ‡ **Tee Time intervals will be 9 minutes apart. Continuing to support safe social distancing practices.**
- ‡ **We will continue to limit the number of players on course at one time. Please call ahead.**
- ‡ **We will continue to provide sanitizing stations.**
- ‡ **Each green will have a modified cup. Pin in place. Please, DO NOT TOUCH THE PIN.**
- ‡ **One player only per golf cart, unless from the same social circle.**
- ‡ **No Benches.**
- ‡ **No Rakes.**
- ‡ **No on course Drinking Water supplied.**
- ‡ **No Garbage Cans. Please, TAKE ALL YOUR GARBAGE WITH YOU.**
- ‡ **Golfers must leave the course immediately following their round.**
- ‡ We are still requiring our employees to stay home if they feel unwell or if they have been in contact with anyone that is exhibiting flu-like symptoms.
- ‡ Increasing cleanliness of our facilities especially in high traffic areas.
- ‡ Notices throughout our facility for customers and employees to use caution and practice best hygiene methods to prevent the spread of the virus

*The Christina Lake Golf Club* will continue to monitor the recommendations of government and health officials as well as industry best practices and pass along relevant information and updates as necessary.
